



Terms and Conditions for the prize – Second Level

The Prize is a trip to Silicon Valley and San Francisco with site visits to industries who are leaders in their sectors and will be awarded to the Winner of the Young Entrepreneur Programme (Second Level) for 2010 to be announced on 22nd April 2010.

Terms & Conditions Apply to the Prize.

1. There is no cash alternative.
2. The Trip has been pre-organised within the USA and the Winner and agreed Educator (if more than one educator was involved in class delivery) must be available to travel between 12th June 2010 and 18th June 2010 and be prepared to participate fully in the Itinerary.
3. Attendees for pre-arranged meetings are limited to the Winner, Educator and YEP representative(s).
4. The Prize is personal to the Winner and no element of it is transferrable.
5. Anybody other than the agreed Educator wishing to travel with the Winner must make their own travel and itinerary arrangements and pay their own costs.
6. Prior Parental consent is required for any Winner who will be Under 18 on the date of departure from Ireland.
7. It is the responsibility of the Winner and agreed Educator to ensure that his/her passport is valid and all necessary visas are in order.
8. All travel and medical insurance cover is the responsibility of the Winner and his/her travelling companions.
9. YEP relies on the support of the various individuals and businesses who have agreed to meet the Winner in Silicon Valley. However, given the nature of business, circumstances may arise that mean that the itinerary may change at short notice.
10. The winner must also be available and consent to participation in the media plan for this programme, which may include participating in interviews and being photographed, and to the publication/broadcast of same.
11. YEP may require the Winner to participate in certain publicity while in Silicon Valley as well as in Ireland.
12. There may be circumstances where YEP decides that it would be better to change the itinerary or to change the travel dates, and it fully reserves the right to do so.
13. The Winner must be willing to attend a 2 hour mentor support workshop with the Kerry County Enterprise Board.
14. The Winner must be willing to take up a 2 week work placement with one of the Mentor Companies, if offered.
